

## Behavioral health services for central and south Florida – Carelon Behavioral Health

Preauthorization and medical necessity reviews for mental health, substance abuse and partial/residential treatment for Medicaid members are managed by Carelon Behavioral Health (formerly Beacon Health Options) for the following regions:

- **Region 3**: Alachua, Bradford, Citrus, Columbia, Dixie, Gilchrist, Hamilton, Hernando, Lafayette, Lake, Levy, Marion, Putnam, Sumter, Suwannee and Union counties
- Region 4: Baker, Clay, Duval, Flagler, Nassau, St. Johns and Volusia counties
- Region 5: Pasco and Pinellas counties
- Region 6: Hardee, Highlands, Hillsborough, Manatee and Polk counties
- Region 7: Brevard, Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties
- Region 8: Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, Hendry, Lee and Sarasota counties
- Region 9: Indian River, Martin, Okeechobee, Palm Beach and St. Lucie counties
- Region 10: Broward County
- Region 11: Miami-Dade and Monroe counties

Carelon Behavioral Health manages preauthorization requests for the following services:

- Residential Treatment Center (SIPP)
- Inpatient Mental Health
- Inpatient Detoxification
- Inpatient Rehabilitation
- Crisis Stabilization
- Intensive Outpatient
- Therapeutic Behavioral Onsite Services (TBOSS)
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS)
- Partial Hospital
- Targeted Case Management

## How to submit preauthorization requests

Inpatient preauthorization requests for behavioral health services can be submitted to
Carelon by calling 844-265-7590. A licensed clinician is available 24 hours a day. During regular
business hours (Monday – Friday, 8:30 a.m. – 6 p.m., Eastern time), choose the prompt for
inpatient admissions. After-hour calls will be routed to an on-call clinician.

An authorization determination will be made at the time of the call. The following information is needed to determine medical necessity:

- Date and time of admission
- o Member name, date of birth, health plan name and plan ID number

- o Type of admission: voluntary, involuntary, court-ordered, etc.
- Diagnosis
- Presenting symptoms
- Precipitating event
- Clinical history (including history of inpatient, outpatient, alternate treatment modalities)
- Medications and adherence
- o Significant comorbidities, medical issues, complications
- o Toxicology screen results, current relevant laboratory results
- Name of attending physician
- o Name of facility contact person and his/her phone number
- **For outpatient preauthorization requests,** only the following services require preauthorization:
  - o Psychosocial rehabilitation
  - Therapeutic behavioral on-site services
  - o Targeted case management
  - Behavioralhealth overlay services
  - o Therapeutic services for members in foster care
