Find a doctor or see if your doctor is in the network

- Go to Humana.com.
- Select "Find a doctor" in the green section at the bottom of the page.
- Choose "Medical" under search type.
- Select "Insurance through your employer" for coverage type.
- Enter your ZIP code.
- Select "Dayton + Cincy/Northern KY HMOx" for network.
- Select option by "Name," "Specialty," "Condition" or "All" under "Search".
- Fill in text field with provider name, specialty or condition.
- Select "Search" button.

- The Dayton+Cincinnati/Northern KY HMOx includes a network of qualified PCPs, including family practitioners, general practitioners, internists and pediatricians.
- PCP selection is required; you'll be prompted to select your PCP when you enroll.
- You can change your PCP whenever you wish by going to MyHumana at Humana.com.

Frequently asked questions

What if I choose to see a doctor who is not in my network?

You'll have to pay for your services in full, and Humana will be unable to limit the amount you pay.

What if I need to see a doctor who is not in my network?

If it is medically necessary and coordinated through your PCP, services outside your network will be covered the same as if you were going to a provider in your network.

What if I go to an emergency room outside my network?

If you are traveling, or go to an emergency room outside of your network, and it's a true emergency, services will be covered at the in-network benefit level. You'll be expected to receive all follow-up care from your PCP or an in-network provider.

Is a High-Value Network HMO right for me?

It's a good choice for people who are willing to use certain doctors and healthcare facilities in exchange for lower costs. Your PCP plays a valuable role by providing you with many of your healthcare services and helping you find a specialist if needed. Your PCP keeps an eye on your total healthcare picture and is the point person anytime you have a health problem. Preventive care like annual checkups, flu shots and screenings are covered at 100% at your PCP's office.
