What to know, before you get your medicine – quantity limits Understanding your pharmacy benefits



You may take prescription medicines to stay healthy. You may take some medicines for a short time, like an antibiotic to treat an infection. You may take other medicines all the time to treat problems like high blood pressure. Either way, it's important to know quantity limits apply before your prescription is filled.

Quantity limits

Quantity limits are the maximum amount of a medicine your plan will cover for one copayment or over a certain number of days. For example, you may fill no more than 60 pills in a 30-day period of time.

Why are quantity limits required?

Quantity limits help keep you safe, which is very important if you're taking certain medicines. Having quantity limits on the amount of medicine you can receive helps you get the right dose for your condition.

How do I find out if my medicine has a quantity limit?

- **Search online:** Go to **Humana.com** and register for MyHumana, your personal, secure online account Use our online Drug List search by selecting "Drug Pricing" under "Plan Tools" at the bottom of the page to look up your medicines and find out which ones have quantity limits. You also can print a Drug List, look at medicine costs and see if you have other medicine choices.
- Call us: You can call the Customer Care number on the back of your Humana member ID card to find out which of your medicines have quantity limits.
