ARIZONA

In Maricopa County, all healthcare professionals may submit applications for Medicare Advantage private fee-for-service contracts. For other products in Maricopa County, Humana is only accepting applications from the following providers and specialties: cardiology, colon/rectal, dermatology, dialysis centers, ear/nose/throat, endocrinology, freestanding ancillary and imaging, hematology/oncology, gastroenterology, infectious disease, maternal/fetal medicine, ophthalmology, pediatric subspecialty, perinatology/neonatology, radiation oncology, reproductive endocrinology and rheumatology.

COLORADO

In the Denver Metro and Colorado Springs service areas, all healthcare professionals may submit applications for Medicare Advantage private fee-for-service contracts. For other products, Humana is only accepting applications from obstetricians/gynecologists and oral and maxillofacial surgeons in these counties: Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, El Paso, Jefferson and Teller.

SOUTH FLORIDA

Primary Care Physicians interested in a contract for the Commercial line of business only may use the online application process. Primary care physicians, specialists and ancillary providers interested in a contract with a combination of Medicare, Medicaid and/or commercial lines of business please submit your Letter of Interest to requesttojoin@Humana.com.

MISSISSIPPI

Effective Jan. 1, 2021, Humana will no longer have Medicare Advantage Private Fee-for-Service plans in Mississippi. Mississippi is accepting applications in all medical specialties and counties except for physical/speech/occupational therapy in Hancock, Harrison, Hinds, Madison and Rankin counties.

Mississippi is not accepting applications from home health or skilled nursing facilities in any county.
