To what extent will Humana cover the Hepatitis A vaccine for adults? (Ages 21+)	 Humana has opted to allow coverage for adult beneficiaries (21+) that meet one of the following high-risk categories as bulleted below. This benefit be offered for a limited time; Humana will work collaboratively with the State to determine the timeframe of this benefit, and will keep the provider network informed. Individuals that are homeless Intravenous drug users Non-intravenous illicit drug users Men who have sex with men Individuals in an emergency room or other acute care setting, after being administered an opioid antagonist, such as naloxone Individuals working with homeless persons or intravenous drug users Individuals over 60 years of age with a serious underlying medical condition, as determined by their health care provider, in critically impacted counties and/or First responders
How should you bill Humana?	Paper and electronic HCFA 1500 (professional) claims are acceptable billing forms – you should bill both the administration code, along with the vaccine code itself (CPT code 90632). All normal paper and electronic submission requirements apply.
What will Humana's reimbursement be?	Humana will reimburse this vaccine at the rate loaded on the Medicaid Fee Schedule for ages 19-20 year olds (\$67.55). This will be reimbursed each time it is billed for the two-dose vaccine. There will be no separate reimbursement for the administration code.
Will Humana require authorization for services?	Humana will not require an authorization for beneficiaries that qualify for the benefit, as noted in the first row (above).
Will there be any copayment requirements for this benefit?	No, there will not be any copayment requirements to Humana members for this expanded benefit.
