



## COVID-19 vaccine enrollment and requirements

Currently, pharmacies must enroll and sign an agreement with the U.S. government to receive and administer the COVID-19 vaccine. For more guidance, view COVID-19 vaccine information found at [www.cms.gov/covidvax](http://www.cms.gov/covidvax).

Pharmacies that enroll and sign an agreement with the U.S. government to administer the vaccine are required to:

- Provide the vaccine recipient with the emergency use authorization (EUA) fact sheets on the vaccine and the vaccination cards.
- Communicate the need for the vaccine recipient to receive both doses of the same vaccine, when required.
- Administer the vaccine in accordance with requirements from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices.
- Meet the storage requirements.
- Meet the recordkeeping requirements, including recording the administration of the vaccine to patients in the pharmacy's system within 24 hours and reporting to public health data systems within 72 hours.
