



Information about the launch of generic Copaxone

Effective Jan. 1, 2022, generic Copaxone (glatiramer acetate) is not covered for CarePlus patients. Brand-name Copaxone will continue to be covered and can be filled for the patient.

Prescriber frequently asked questions on generic Copaxone

1. Q: Are generic Copaxone (glatiramer acetate) products being covered at the pharmacy?

A: The generic glatiramer acetate products, including Glatopa, are not covered. For CarePlus plans, brand-name Copaxone products are covered and can be filled for your patients.

2. Q: Why aren't generic glatiramer acetate products covered?

A: CarePlus decided not to cover generic glatiramer acetate products at this time; brand-name Copaxone is on the formulary.

3. Q: Can I request an exception for generic glatiramer acetate products?

A: It is possible, but the cost share for generic glatiramer acetate products may be the same or higher than Copaxone.

4. Q: Will generic glatiramer acetate products be covered in the future?

A: CarePlus may cover generic glatiramer acetate products at some point in the future.
