

Prescriber frequently asked questions on generic Combigan

1. Q: Are generic Combigan (brimonidine-timolol) products being covered at the pharmacy?

A: For Humana’s commercial, Medicare Advantage prescription drug and Medicare Part D plans, brand-name Combigan can be filled for patients. Generic brimonidine-timolol is not covered.

2. Q: Why isn’t generic brimonidine-timolol covered?

A: Humana decided not to cover generic brimonidine-timolol at this time; brand-name Combigan is on the formulary.

3. Q: Can I request an exception for generic brimonidine-timolol?

A: Yes, but the cost share for generic brimonidine-timolol may be the same as or higher than brand-name Combigan.

4. Q: Will generic brimonidine-timolol be covered in the future?

A: Humana may cover generic brimonidine-timolol at some point in the future.
