Reducing emissions and waste

In 2018, we established next-generation goals to make environmental sustainability a key factor in our business strategy.

Greenhouse gas emissions reduction

Goal: 10.5% decrease in greenhouse gas emissions from 2017 baseline across our portfolio of owned and leased properties.



35% achieved reduction

Goal: 10.5%

Waste diversion

Goal: 60% diversion rate of waste to landfills via reduction and recycling efforts at portfolio sites where Humana and vendors manage waste and recycling.



64% achieved diversion rate

Goal: 60%

Science-based targets

Components of our near-term science-based targets (SBTs)—designed using climate science, the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) methodology and SBTi's official target setting tool—are illustrated below. We anticipate receiving SBTi's validation of our SBT later in 2023 and will communicate accordingly.

Scope 1 and Scope 2

54.6%

Humana commits to reduce absolute Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions 54.6% by 2032 from a 2019 base year. Scope 3

30%

Humana commits to a 30% absolute reduction in Scope 3 GHG emissions covering purchased goods and services and upstream transportation by 2032 from a 2021 base year.

Reducing resource waste

We use certifications to benchmark and update our standards for our physical locations to better reduce energy usage, improve employee health and eliminate waste. That includes: ENERGY STAR, Fitwel and TRUE Zero Waste certification.
